The Arsenal Double Club evaluation (Playing for Success)



The Arsenal Double Club project works with underachieving pupils in key stage 3 to improve attainment, particularly in literacy and numeracy. Providing an innovative 'double experience' programme, the project combines classroom education with coaching in football or another sport. This project will determine the effectiveness of the scheme, identify good practice and provide evidence on how best to roll out Double Clubs to other schools.
