

# NFER Attitude Surveys

## Primary Pupil Survey Key Findings - Summer 2011

### NFER Primary School

The NFER pupil survey was completed by 110 pupils in your school. For every question in the survey we have calculated whether there is a significant difference in the rating applied to each statement by your pupils compared to all pupils in the national sample.

The 10 areas where your school is most successful(1) and the 10 areas where your school is least successful(2) compared to other schools which took part in the survey are shown below. Those that are statistically significant(3) are marked with an asterisk.

#### Areas of strength

In your school, pupils.....

- are less likely to say "Naughty children make it hard for me to learn" \*
- are more likely to say "It is important to do my homework" \*
- are more likely to say "People I live with help me with my homework" \*
- are less likely to worry about being out in the dark in the area where they live \*
- are more likely to say "I eat 5 pieces of fruit or vegetables" \*
- are less likely to worry about being followed by other people in the area where they live \*
- are more likely to think they are doing well in ICT
- are more likely to say "I think I will be happy when I am a grown up" \*
- are more likely to say "I sit down to eat with the people I live with"
- are less likely to worry about strangers in the area where they live

#### Areas of concern

In your school, pupils.....

- are less likely to say "Children do what teachers tell them"
- are less likely to say "Children who behave well get rewards"
- are less likely to say "My school says it is important to exercise or do sport" \*
- are less likely to say "My teachers have helped me feel confident" \*
- are less likely to say "It is easy to get to clubs and activities" \*
- are less likely to say "When I need help I talk to a grown up at my school" \*
- are less likely to say "It is important to have a school council" \*
- are less likely to say "My teachers listen to me" \*
- are more likely to say "I eat takeaway food" \*
- are less likely to be consulted about changes in school \*

(1) Questions are ordered by statistical significance. If there are less than 10 questions where responses are more positive than for other schools, the list will include questions where responses are less positive by the smallest amount.

(2) Questions are ordered by statistical significance. If there are less than 10 questions where responses are less positive than for other schools, the list will include questions where responses are more positive by the smallest amount.

(3) Implies a statistically significant difference at the 0.05 level between responses in your school and responses in the national sample. For "areas of strength" only positive differences are flagged. For "areas of concern" only negative differences are flagged.
